€29 per student for this school tour package. The price is inclusive of full supervision at all activities.

Teachers are allowed to take part in activities if they wish but there is no obligation to do so, there is no charge for teachers who wish to participate.

Each teacher will receive a welcome gift and a free lunch on-site.

If you book our school tour day by 1st April, you will receive a 99% discount voucher for one child to attend Camp Rockwell. This voucher can be used by the organising teacher or perhaps as a fundraiser in the school.

HOW TO BOOK A SCHOOL TOUR

Book a school tour by logging onto www.camprockwell.ie and clicking on Bookings; select the School Tour option, or ring **062 61444** for assistance.

Fill in all details on the website and make a deposit payment of €100 via debit or credit card. This will secure the booking. Once the deposit is paid, you will receive a confirmation from us via email.

Exact numbers (if different from the booking numbers) can be communicated to us after the initial booking. The final number of students that arrive will be the number of students the school will pay the balance for. The remaining balance is payable **on arrival** for your school tour by card or cheque.

Water sports and outdoor activities are dependent on suitable weather conditions. In the event of unsuitable weather, alternative activities will be organised.

ACTIVITIES

JUNIOR INFANTS - FIRST CLASS: Swimming, Bouncy Castles, Wrecking Ball, Indoor Team Games, Outdoor Team Games, Orienteering, Quads, Art, Nature Trail, Grass Sledging

SECOND CLASS - SIXTH CLASS: Aquapark, Swimming, Kayaking, Bouncy Castles (Large Obstacle Course, Wrecking ball, & Sumo suits), Educational Trail, Indoor Team Games (a choice of Volleyball, Dodge Ball or Olympic Handball), Outdoor Team Games (a choice of Tennis, Soccer, Basketball, Rounders & GAA), Orienteering.

SCHOOL TOUR DAY LAYOUT

- Schools arrive at 9.30am and finish at 3.30pm. If schools wish to arrive & depart at a different time, they must agree this in advance with the Camp Office
- Each group is assigned a group leader. Large groups (30 children max.) will have two group leaders. Junior Infants - First Class groups will always have two group leaders.
- Six hour action-packed day with activities lasting approximately 40 minutes each. The Aquapark will be longer to incorporate wetsuits fitting.
- Students get a 30 minute lunch break supervised by our staff. Students must bring their own packed lunch.

SCHOOL TOUR PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Role of the school Teachers

- To provide a list of students in alphabetical order (per class) to the Tour Manager on arrival.
- To include on that list, details of any child who has a medical issue that we should be aware of.
- Any child that requires an SNA during school hours must have **that** SNA with them on activities at all times.
- Teachers will take charge of any student who requires medical treatment.

Each student / participating teacher should bring:

- Swimwear & two towels
- Casual leisure wear & rain jacket
- Any personal medication or medical devices that they might need for the day
- An old change of clothes for kayaking & rafting for Second - Sixth Class groups (old shoes, shorts & T-shirt). Wetsuits are provided for the Aquapark
- A packed lunch & bottle of water



CANTEEN

Each student should bring their own lunch. Our staff will supervise them in a designated area during lunch.
